#### What is SCRIP?

SCRIP are gift cards/certificates you purchase from St. Alphonsus for the places you do business. SCRIP can be used like cash at hundreds of participating vendor locations. By purchasing SCRIP you can earn a percentage of the certificate value toward your tuition and/or donation to the St. Alphonsus cause of your choice.

If your child is still too young for school, you can "bank" SCRIP to pay for future tuition. Friends and relatives can also purchase SCRIP and opt to credit your tuition account. So be sure to recruit those grandparents, aunts and uncles!

There are no membership fees or minimum orders. Vendors offer these certificates to non-profit organizations at a discount, and the discounts are passed along as a credit to the St. Alphonsus account of your choice. SCRIP earnings can be used to pay for All Saints Academy tuition, Catholic High Schools, parish tithing, Office of Faith Formation programs, or as a donation to the parish, school, endowment, or parish food & clothing center. It's as easy as ordering on Thursday, and picking up your SCRIP on the following Thursday!

### How do I participate?

- Either complete the paper SCRIP Program application and submit it to the Rectory, or register online at www.shopwithscrip.com. Click on Family Sign up-Creat Account. Follow the prompts to set up your online SCRIP account. Enter the fund to which you want your SCRIP profits applied in both the Classroom and Student fields. Use Enrollment Code: 123AB663751
- Order SCRIP either online at www.shopwithscrip.com, or by completing a SCRIP order form, attach payment and submit it to the Rectory by 6:00 PM Thursday. Even if you order online, your order confirmation and payment must be at the rectory by 6:00 PM Thursday.
- Pick up your order the following Thursday, between 1:00 PM and 6:00 pm at the Rectory.
- 4. Spend your SCRIP and reap the benefits!
- 5. Repeat steps 2-4 weekly.
- Verify your quarterly earnings report when it arrives.



- Donate to the Parish, capital campaign, school tuition, or food & clothing center at no extra cost!
- Recruit your friends and relatives to buy scrip to earn extra tuition dollars for you!
- Bank SCRIP for future tuition needs!

### SCRIP Program Terms & Conditions

Earned SCRIP funds will be directed to the St. Alphonsus Parish and/or school tuition account(s) indicated on the front of this form. Written notification must be received by the SCRIP program supervisor 30 days in advance for any changes to be made.

St. Alphonsus Parish will retain up to 1% of the vendor discount for administrative costs. Discount percentages listed on the order form will reflect the full percent available to participants.

SCRIP can be ordered on a weekly basis. The regular SCRIP order and pick-up days may be subject to change due to holidays or other schedule changes. Whenever possible, notification will be given to current SCRIP participants, and be published in parish communications.

SCRIP orders must be picked up and signed out. Since SCRIP is the equivalent of cash, it will not be mailed or sent home with a student courier.

Payments for SCRIP are due at the time the order is placed. Payment can be made by cash, check or money order. Credit or debit cards are not accepted for SCRIP. A \$10.00 fee will be assessed for any checks returned for non-payment. Two or more returned checks will result in a "cash or money order only" payment status.

SCRIP credit percentages and available denominations are subject to change without notice. Participating vendors are also subject to change without notice. St. Alphonsus Parish will make every effort to communicate changes whenever feasible. Participants can also monitor changes at the Great Lakes SCRIP web site: www.glscrip.com.

Statements indicating SCRIP earnings will be published on a quarterly basis. SCRIP earnings will be posted to the selected parish accounts quarterly.

Earned SCRIP funds are non-refundable. Any tuition funds earned in excess of the remaining balance on the tuition account will be applied to the next school year tuition or tithing. All tuition and tithe obligations must be current to save SCRIP funds for future use.
